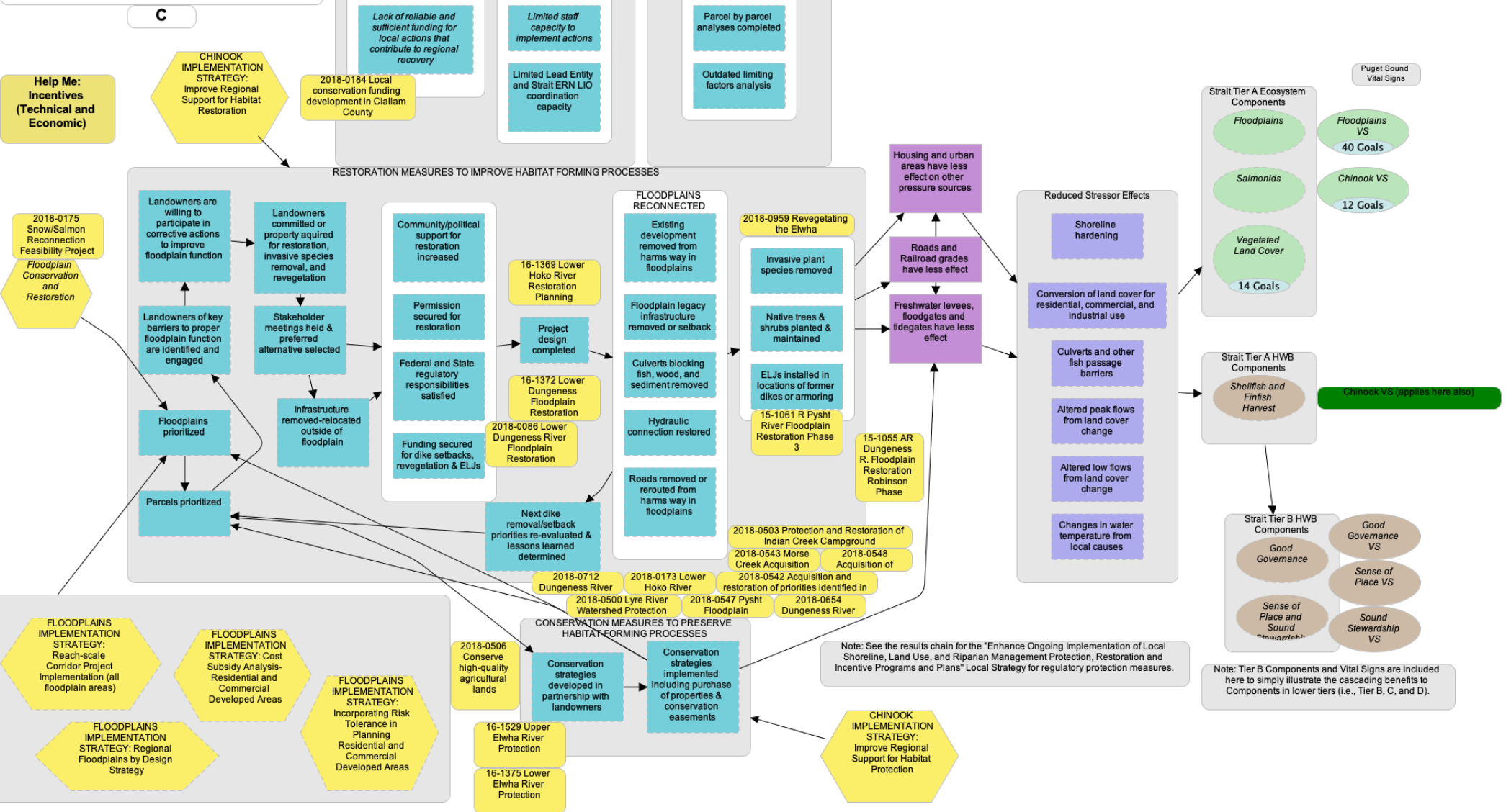


Strait LIO: Floodplain Conservation and Restoration Results Chain
